Liability Release

I understand that there are risks involved with riding and working with horses. These risks include injury, permanent disability and even death. I also understand that the staff at Cross Creek Rodeo Company will take all necessary safety precautions to insure the safety of my child. I hereby, for myself, my spouse, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, fully and completely release and discharge Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch, its owners, operators, sponsors, employees, servants, officers and all other participants, of and from any and all claims, demands, actions, and causes of action of any kind or character for death or any injuries sustained to my person or property, or that of my child or legal charge.

I attest that my child is physically capable to participate in this camp. However, should any employee, volunteer, or representative determine in their sole discretion that completion or participation in any games or events would be injurious to my child's health or should my child become ill or injured, I consent to his or her removal and treatment by any physician or medical care provider at the direction of the camp, employees, volunteers or representatives.

I further acknowledge that Cross Creek Rodeo Company staff has offered the use of a riding helmet in conjunction with the riding part of the camp, and I understand that wearing such riding helmet may prevent or reduce severity of some head injuries as the result of a fall or other occurrence. It is understood that the riding helmet provided by Cross Creek Rodeo Company may not be a perfect fit. I have read and understand the above stated offer of the use of a riding helmet and make the following decision by placing my initials below in the box before the statement which describes my choice for my child to wear, or not to wear a riding helmet.

Protective Riding Helmets

YES, I **request** my child to wear the protective riding helmet which Cross Creek Rodeo Company provides when riding horses.

NO, I **decline** to have my child wear the protective helmet offered by Cross Creek Rodeo Company and I am fully responsible for my child's safety in this decision.

If I choose for my child to not wear a riding helmet I acknowledge that I know and understand the risks involved in choosing not to wear a riding helmet when riding horses. Having acknowledged and accepted said risks, I hereby release Cross Creek Rodeo Company, their heirs, employees, and sponsors and agree to hold them harmless for any and all liabilities, claims, damages, actions and cause of action whatsoever, for death or injury to person/child which Cross Creek Rodeo Company or those others released hereby be charged within connection, directly or indirectly, with the riding or using of a horse while not wearing the riding helmet offered for use in connection therewith.

CAMP POLICIES:

Camp Arrival Time:

We ask that no one arrive before 5:00pm on registration day. All staff are busy preparing for your child's stay at the Ranch and will not be available to check campers in until this time.

In all cases of dismissal, late arrivals, or early departures, no refunds will be given.

Homesickness Policy:

Phone calls home are discouraged, unless it is an emergency. Parents are asked not to visit their children during their stay at camp, in order to prevent homesickness. In the case of severe homesickness - if the camper cannot be consoled and calmed, the parent will be asked to speak to their child on the phone. If the child is unable to stay at camp then, they are asked to come pick up their child. *(on the following day if occurrence is during the night)* Sorry, but no refunds.

Telephone Calls:

Parents may call and speak with the camp staff at any time, however, we do not allow campers to place or receive telephone calls, unless it is an emergency. We do not allow campers to have cell phones at camp.

Trunks and Luggage:

Campers bring their belongings in footlockers or plastic tote containers with lid or duffel bags. Please make sure that all belongings are labeled with child/camper's name. Cross Creek Rodeo Company will not be responsible for lost belongings.

Visitors Policy:

Cross Creek Rodeo Company does not allow visitors during camp. This policy helps encourage campers to focus on the fun opportunities around them, to increase their sense of independence, and to eliminate the unfairness that some would encounter if another camper has a visitor. We have set aside times at the beginning and closing of camp for campers to share their experience and surroundings with their parents/guardians. During closing ceremonies, parents and relatives are welcome to attend.

Electronic Games/Devices:

Cross Creek Rodeo Company will only allow the use of electronic games, MP3 players, cameras or related items/devices to be used at assigned times. The camp has been designed for your child/camper to enjoy the "camping" experience and we feel the use of such devices would interfere with camp activities. These devices are at no time to be used or operated around the livestock at Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch.

Discipline Policy:

If a camper is/has repeatedly disrupted the camp by fighting, insulting others, using foul language, mistreating the animals, or is deemed harmful to other campers, the parent will be notified and asked to retrieve their child/camper immediately. No refunds.

We adhere to the age old policy of *"We treat others as we would want others to treat us!"*

Tobacco/Alcohol/Weapon:

Cross Creek Rodeo Company adheres to a strict policy prohibiting the use or possession by campers of tobacco, alcohol or drugs. Cross Creek Rodeo Company strictly prohibits the use or possession of weapons.

Pets/Animals:

No animals/pets are allowed at camp other than those owned by Cross Creek Rodeo Company.

Photographs/Video Footage:

I give permission to Cross Creek Rodeo Company to allow photographs or video footage of my child taken at camp to be used in Cross Creek Rodeo Companies promotional materials.

Camp Apparel/Jewelry Policy:

Apparel that is disruptive to the camp environment will not be worn at the Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch. This includes, but is not limited to, items that contain profane or indecent words, promote the use of illegal drugs or controlled substances, contain statements, cartoons or caricatures of a sexual nature, and other apparel that disrupts the camp environment.

For the safety of campers, belts are to be secured through belt loops of camper's pants. Belts that hang down or dangle will not be worn by campers. Wallets attached to chains are also unacceptable apparel. The following jewelry is prohibited during camp at Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch: dangling earrings, bracelets, or necklaces. We strongly advise each camper to leave all valuables including jewelry at home.

Campers found to be wearing any of the above prohibited items, clothing or jewelry will be required to remove the disruptive articles. If a camper does not adhere to this policy, parent will be asked to retrieve their child/camper from the Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch.

The following clothing will not be worn at camp:

Girl's tops that show the midriff. Boy's pants that expose undergarments.

Boy's shirts that show an excess of skin (loose tank tops with large arm holes).

Shorts are only worn during specified times at camp.

During certain camp activities each child/camper shall wear long pants and boots with heels.

Everyone that rides or handles horses must be wearing hard-soled boots with heels (a great example is the tan work boots sold at Wal-Mart). "Official" western boots are not required. A hiking boot is acceptable as long as the tread is not too thick. Ankle support is important when riding. We do not allow anyone in tennis shoes, sandals, or flip-flops to ride or handle horses.

Each of these policies has been put in place to create a safe and friendly environment at the Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch. We ask that you read each policy carefully, discuss and explain each policy to your child, and encourage you to ask any questions prior to registration. We strive to ensure each child/camper has a positive learning experience during his/her camp time at Cross Creek Rodeo Ranch.
